What is preventive care?

Preventive care includes tests, shots (vaccines), screenings and other care to help your children avoid illness before they have symptoms of a problem.

Your Marketplace plan pays the full cost of certain preventive care services from a doctor or other providers in your plan's network. This means you don't have to pay a copay or co-insurance or meet your deductible.

Your children may not need all of these services. Ask their doctor which services your children should get based on their sex, age and family history:
