What is preventive care?

Preventive care includes tests, shots (vaccines), screenings and other care to help you avoid illness before you have symptoms of a problem.

Your Marketplace plan pays the full cost of certain preventive care services from a doctor or other providers in your plan's network. This means you don't have to pay a copay or co-insurance or meet your deductible.

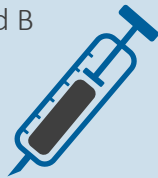
You may not need all of these services. Some services are only free to people at high risk, such as colon cancer screening for people over 50.

Preventive care services covered by your Marketplace plan

Ask your doctor which services you should get based on your sex, age and family history:

Vaccines

- Chickenpox
- Flu
- Hepatitis A and B
- Measles
- Pneumonia
- Tetanus
- Others

- Abdominal aortic aneurysm
- Blood pressure
- Cholesterol
- Hepatitis B and C
- Type 2 Diabetes



Counseling

- Healthy eating
- Weight loss
- Depression
- Alcohol
- Smoking



Regular visits

- Yearly wellness checkup



Cancer screenings

- Colon cancer
- Lung cancer



Sexually transmitted disease (STD) screenings

- HIV
- Syphilis
- Sexually transmitted infection (STI) counseling

- Prescription aspirin to help prevent heart disease
